Big Project in Livingston

The foundation of the main building at the Livingston mission has been eroding away for several years. Martin realized that we needed to do something about it. When we checked with a "dirt" man, he said all we needed were rain gutters with downspouts to carry the rain water away from the building. The cost of the gutters (with leaf guards) is just over \$13,000, of which we have paid 40%, with the rest due when the job is completed.

We praise God that a Foundation in Livingston donated a year-end gift of \$12,000 which will more than pay the rest of the cost as well as replace most of what we drew out of a special account to pay the 40%.

God has promised to provide what His children need and He often

uses His other children's willing obedience to meet those needs. We all belong to Him and all that we have belongs to Him. As we seek Him, trust Him, and obey Him, our needs will be met and God can use us to meet the needs of others.
