Michael landed on our doorstep the beginning of December. He started helping out around the mission. He, too, was interested in attending the Christian Men's Job Corps at The Fieldhouse. Michael followed the rules. Of course, he attended Bible study twice a day. So he heard the Word. Michael was not too interested in God, but he was very respectful. He and Warren would have discussions about the Lord.

God's plan kicked in and guess what!? Michael gave his heart to the Lord early February. Now our Bible studies have more meaning for him. Michael had a medical emergency and was in the hospital for a few days. He missed going to class and was so glad to get home. He is back on track and looking forward to graduation on the 18th of May.

Jennifer and her daughter came had a job and she had childcare for her daughter. She has been saving her money and is taking her time to find the right place for her and her daughter.

Selena is back. She stayed at the Nacogdoches GODTEL and had to leave for cutting screens. We gave her a second chance in Lufkin. We let her know we would be watching her closely. She made plans to go to drug rehab. While waiting on a bed, Selena made a decision for Christ. She got the call about an open bed. And so she packed her bags and headed for help. After six weeks she came back to Lufkin and GODTEL. Because she is now attending outpatient sessions she is able to work. Selena is working at What-A-Burger. She has a delightful smile and contagious laugh.

Jessica and her two children checked in towards the end of the month. Both children were in school. They were waiting for the beginning of May to move out. Jessica found a place for her and her children. In the few days she was here she had a medical emergency. She was sent to Houston for minor surgery. She returned a day later and was able to move out on time.

Amber and her four children checked in the end of the month. She lost her job and couldn't pay rent and was evicted. She and her children are safe, warm and dry these days. The three older children are in school. The baby is almost a year old. It will take her awhile to get her life together. We know the best fixer upper is Jesus and it is not an accident that she and her children are here. Pray for God to become real in her life and see what the next chapter brings.

Sadly, we had to tell a few people to leave for breaking the rules. We thank the Lord that we are here to help people whether they heed the rules or not. Some are thankful, some are not.
